

## SWIP Plan 2017-2018

### Plan Components:

#### 1. Prioritized Needs:

A. We have a need to implement a specific intervention program that identifies students in need of assistance and helps to identify specific interventions to fill in gaps that exist. The program also needs to have component to progress monitor individual students for learning and growth.

B. We have a need to educate our parents regarding our Singapore Math Program and give them strategies that they can use in the home to provide assistance to their student(s).

#### 2. Goals:

A. By the conclusion of the 2017-2018 school year the team will have visited multiple schools to research various programs and make a recommendation to the committee for a program or programs that will work best for Xavier.

B. During the 2017-2018 school year we will survey parents regarding interest in a Math night. If favorable a Family Math Night will be scheduled where the math program is explained and games/strategies will be introduced to families to aid in math instruction.

#### 3. Intervention Strategy:

A. Schedule a math night for families to describe the Singapore Math program and introduce families to games and strategies they can use in the home to assist their students.

#### 4. Monitoring

A. The plan will be monitored by the head of schools as well as the Title coordinator to ensure:

- i. Thoroughness of research into potential school programs in order to make a recommendation moving forward into 2018-2019.
- ii. The implementation of Family Math Night in grades K-8
