VI. Reports/ Discussion Items

- **A.** Patriot Pen Essay Student Recital Ms. Lisa Thompson invited Tylee Heider, an 8th grader, to read her essay.
- **B. PFA Report-** Kate Henna gave a big thanks to everyone who attended and helped with the Chick-fil-a Spirit Night. They raised \$599. The Culver's Spirit Night will be held on December

18 from 4-8 p.m. in coordination with Showcase week. She stated that the ButterBraid Fundraiser raised around \$15,800. They will be using the money to build a track on school grounds.

- C. Teachers and Classified Employee of the Month- Mr. Moon presented the Elementary Teacher of the Month for November/December who was Ms. Debbie Barrutia, 4th Grade Teacher. Mr. Goss presented the Secondary Teacher of the Month for November/December who was Ms. Paige Ivey, Science Teacher. He also presented the Classified Employee of the Month for November/December, Niki Heidemann, who works in the Dance Department.
- **D.** Insurance Renewal Rates: Cody McQueen He presented the insurance renewal rates which increased for the 2020 enrollment year. He also presented other options with other insurance companies. He recommended that XCS stay with the grandmothered plan.

E. K-6 and 7-12/HOS/AHOS/Building and Maintenance Reports

- 1. Gary Moon Head of Schools: He presented the enrollment numbers. He stated the fencing around the school has been completed. He informed the Board that Creekside Road will be finished by Monday, and administration will be moving the drop-off and pick-up back so it is all on XCS property. Mr. Wallace volunteered to donate a magnet to help keep the property clear of metal debris. XCS will be sending a team to Phoenix in March for classical education training. For Veteran's Day, the Elementary children made art projects with family veteran pictures as a tribute.
- **2. Jon Goss Assistant Head of Schools:** He reported the arena style parent/teacher conference was attended by about 40% of the parents this fall. He stated the ASVAB test was administered to the secondary school students, and the results will be given to them. Amanda Loosli scheduled the testing for students in a two-week window, April 13-24.
- 3. Lisa Thompson 7-12: She stated the history teachers are using the tenets and applying it to their history curriculum as it continues to be developed. She read some parts of the papers written by the students for Patriots Pen "What Makes America Great".
- **4. Becky Baird K-6:** She stated Math Night went well and 182 students attended. She stated that she is working on the Xavier Community Open House, and it is scheduled for Thursday, February 27 from 5:00-6:30 p.m. She is anticipating the Board members to participate in the open house. She presented a book review on <u>The American Ideal of 1776</u> by Hamilton Albert Long.
- **5. Building and Maintenance** Mr. Moon presented Mr. Loosli's report which included updates on the fence, windows, electrical work, air conditioning unit, water softener, garage door replacement, and the road project.
- **F.** Safety Committee Report Ms. McFarland stated that the Safety Week was a success. A full ALICE drill with everyone in the building went well, and the police department did not arrive during the drill. A final drill for the school year will be in April 2020. She reported the new radios have arrived and will be dispersed.
