The following skills should be mastered prior to coming into Sixth Grade:

Language Arts:

- Read and summarize at least 50 lines of text
- Answer a question in a complete sentence with correct capitalization and punctuation while restating the question in the response
- Write multiple, well-formed paragraphs on a given topic
- Use basic capitalization and punctuation rules in writing
- Use and recognize the 8 parts of speech: noun, pronoun, verb, adjective, adverb, preposition, conjunction, and interjection
- Legibly write all upper and lower case letters in print and cursive

Math:

- Fluently recall math facts 0-12
- Identify place value up to hundred millions
- Can create and recognize equivalent fractions
- Add and subtract fractions
- Can express fractions as decimals
- Find the perimeter of squares, triangles, and composite shapes
- Can accurately complete long multiplication and long division problems
