The following skills should be mastered prior to coming into Third Grade:

Language Arts:

- Read at 2.9 level (Magic Tree House series, Junie B. Jones series, etc.)
- Read a variety of texts fluently and independently, and recall main details
- Legibly write all upper and lower case letters in print and cursive
- Answer a question in a complete sentence, with correct capitalization and punctuation, while restating the question in the response
- Write a five-sentence paragraph featuring a topic and conclusion sentence
Provide an example from the text to support your opinion
- Sequence or identify the beginning, middle, and end of a story after reading

Math:

- Automaticity of addition and subtraction facts to 20
- Know multiplication and division facts for 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, and 10s.
- Identify place value up to one thousand
- Represent and solve problems involving addition and subtraction within 100, regrouping groups of 10 when needed
- Mastery of telling time to the nearest 5 minutes, utilizing language of telling time to the hour, half hour, and quarter
- Compare and order fractions with either the same numerator or same denominator
- Partition shapes to show $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, and $\frac{1}{4}$
- Recognize coins and their values
- Compare and order numbers to 1,000
- Use symbols to compare two-digit numbers ($<$, $>$, and $=$)

Please be sure to review any of the above skills with your child if you believe your child may be deficient in one or more areas.
